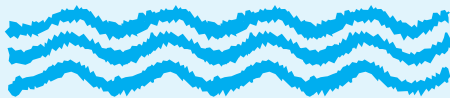

## Proof of Residency

Patrons must show one of the following proofs of residency: Drivers License, Tax Bill, State ID, or a current lease. **If proof of residency is not shown, it will result in a non-resident charge. Residents must show Resident ID Discount Card to receive a discounted price. Sorry, there will be no exceptions.**

## Guest Privileges

A Non-Resident guest accompanied by an Adult Resident (18 years or older) with a Season Pass or Resident ID Discount Card, allows the guest to pay the Resident daily fee (limit 2 guests).

## Closing Guidelines

1. Hall Quarry Beach will not open for swim lessons or public swimming if the weather is raining and/or the air temperature is below 70 degrees.
2. If rain stops and/or air temperature reaches 70 degrees before 5:30 p.m. or 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, the Hall Quarry Beach will open for the remainder of the scheduled hours.
3. There is no minimum air temperature from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 a.m. during Adult Morning Swim.
4. Hall Quarry Beach may close if there are less than 10 patrons in the park, or if the air temperature falls below 70 degrees.
5. If thunder is heard or lightning is sighted during swimming hours, operations will be suspended for a minimum of 30 minutes or the Quarry will close as is appropriate for the situation.
6. Tornado "watches" will be announced to the patrons.
7. In the event of a tornado "warning" the park will be closed and all patrons will be directed to immediately leave the facility.
8. Parents are required to pick-up their children or make arrangements for their children to be picked up promptly. Please make sure your children have telephone numbers and names of people they can contact for rides to reach home safely.
9. NO rain tickets will be issued.
10. 50 meter lanes will close when North beach closes

## 2006 Non-Resident Season Passes

Non-resident season passes will be available starting April 10th. Each non-resident pass will get you admission to Hall Quarry Beach for the 2006 summer season. Each individual non-resident season pass is \$110 each. Come one, come all and enjoy the summer season at Hall Quarry Beach.

## Save Money With A Resident ID Discount Card

Receive the Resident daily fee at a discount with a Resident ID Discount Card! This ID provides a proof of residency and allows patrons to receive a discount off the regular Resident Daily Fee. The Park District reserves the right to request re-verification within the two-year period. The Resident ID Discount Card is available for \$5 and is valid for two years from the date of issue.

## Season Pass & Resident I.D. Discount Card Registration Information

***Sorry, Season Passes are non-refundable.***

- All registration will be done on special three part forms. Forms will be available at the Civic Center and the Eastside Community Center beginning **April 1, 2006**.
- Pre-season registration will be taken at the Civic Center during office hours and special pass registration times (see "Pre-Season Pass Registration Hours"). Starting **Saturday, May 27**, registration will be taken during open hours at the Quarry.
- When registering for a Season Pass or Resident ID Discount Card, you must show one of the following proofs of residency: Driver's License, Property Tax Bill, State ID or a current lease.
- All full-time baby-sitters and nannies that work for Batavia Park District families (Resident or Non-Resident) will need to purchase their own season passes at the Resident rate. **Non-Resident children are not eligible to purchase a Season Pass even though their babysitter or nanny is a Batavia Park District Resident.**
- **If your Resident ID Discount Card was issued in 2004, you will need a new card. If your Card was issued in 2005, you will not need a new card.**
- Please bring last years' (2005) Season Pass/Resident ID Discount Card with you at the time of registration. Your pass will be validated with a sticker when you make payment for the 2006 season. Stickers will not be given out if a Season Pass/Resident ID Discount Card is not available.
- If you no longer have last year's Resident ID Discount Card, you may purchase a new one for \$5. The new Card will be available for two years and made available to you when payment is made for the 2006 season.
- When registering for a new Season Pass/Resident ID Discount Card, the entire family does not need to be present. Family members not present at registration may have their picture taken at a later date.
- Season Passes or Resident ID Discount Cards must be presented for free admittance or discount. **Sorry, no exceptions.**
- Loss of privilege will result from misuse of card or failure to abide by rules.
- The Resident ID Discount Card you receive when you register is good for two years. **Please keep all pool passes.**
- 50 Meter lanes will close when North beach is closed.

## Important Information

### Minimum Age Requirements

Children **twelve** years of age or younger will not be permitted to enter the Hall Quarry Beach facility without the supervision of a responsible person **sixteen** years of age or older. This policy is due to the inability of young children to fully appreciate the dangers of the water and other hazards.

### Non Smoking Policy

Please abide by the Non-Smoking Policy at the Hall Quarry Beach. This policy will be strongly enforced.

### Closings Due to Inclement Weather

The Hall Quarry Beach will be open whenever weather conditions permit. While public safety is our primary responsibility during extreme weather conditions, fiscal responsibility for the taxpayers of the Batavia Park District is our concern during marginal weather conditions. The Batavia Park District reserves the right to close the Hall Quarry Beach at anytime during extreme and marginal weather conditions.

### Quarry Exit and Re-entry

Exiting the Hall Quarry Beach is not permitted without a valid reason. Patrons who have a need to make a short departure from the Quarry are asked to make their intentions known to the cashier or admissions person prior to leaving the park.

### Diaper Rule for Young Swimmers

Recent concerns about the spread of E-coli and other bacteria at aquatic facilities have caused the Illinois Department of Public Health to create new rules requiring non-toilet trained children to wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants at pools or beaches. To comply with this rule, the Batavia Park District requires all children, 30 months of age or younger, to wear a "swim diaper", a tight fitting rubber or plastic pair of pants or a swimsuit with a rubber or plastic lining. Parents will be required to purchase a swim diaper for their children if they do not have the appropriate garments when entering the park. Swim diapers are available at the Quarry for \$1.

### Picnic Information

No coolers allowed inside the fences. Coolers must be left in cars. Picnic Area is located outside the fence at the North end of the Quarry.

# Regulations

## Proper Swimwear Requirements

Patrons will not be permitted to enter the water if they are wearing jean shorts or other street clothes. Tee shirts are permitted when worn over a swimsuit. Swimmers will not be allowed to use the Quarry's slides if their swimwear has metal parts or other objects that may scratch the slides.

- Proper swimwear required. All patrons under the age of 30 months need to wear a swim diaper, tight fitting rubber or plastic pants, or a swimsuit with a rubber or plastic lining. Children without one of these garments will not be permitted to go on the sand beach or enter the water.
- All patrons over the age of 30 months must wear a swimsuit before entering the water. Cutoffs and street clothes are not permitted. Patrons may wear a tee shirt over their swimsuit. Patrons wearing swimsuits with zippers or any other metal objects may not use the slides. No boxer shorts allowed under swimwear.
- Deep water passes must be sewn on suits.

## Supervision of Children

- Children 12 years of age or younger will not be allowed into the beach facility without supervision due to the inability to fully appreciate the danger of the water and other hazards.
- No person 15 years or younger will be allowed to supervise a child 12 years or younger.

## Food & Beverages

- **All outside food and beverages will be prohibited from entering the Quarry. No outside food or beverage will be allowed inside the gates of the beach. All food and beverage must be left in your vehicle. If you wish to picnic at the Quarry, there will be grills and tables outside the north gate. Please use these areas if you wish to picnic at the Quarry.**

- Alcoholic beverages and glass containers of any kind are strictly prohibited.

## Safety Concerns

- Running is prohibited on decks and stairways.
- Hall Quarry Beach is a non smoking facility. There are designated smoking areas outside the facility only.
- Games which interfere with the safety of swimmers are prohibited.
- For the safety of our swimmers, the Batavia Park District reserves the right to require a deep water swimming test for all patrons who enter the deep water areas.
- Admission to the beach is refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, carbuncles, boils, inflamed eyes, ear discharges, or any other conditions that has the appearance of being infected. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages of any kind are not permitted.

## Swim Accessories/Devices

- No hardballs, tennis balls, or raquetballs allowed.
- No masks or snorkels allowed.
- No balls or floatation devises in the deep water areas.
- Batavia Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

## Swimming/Diving Tidbits

- Diving in the shallow water is not permitted.
- Swimming will not be permitted after sunset.
- Caution shall be exercised in the use of diving board and platforms.
- Buoyed lines mark the 5 foot depth of the quarry beach water. Depths beyond the buoyed lines is greater than 5 feet.
- 50 meter lanes will close when the north beach is closed.

## Code of Conduct

To provide an enjoyable environment for everyone, patrons using the Hall Quarry Beach are required to comply with specific standards of behavior established by the Batavia Park District. Copies of the Code of Conduct are available at the Quarry, Civic Center and the Eastside Community Center. Parents are asked to review the Code of Conduct with their children.

- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing in the nose or otherwise introducing contaminants into the beach water area is not permitted.
- A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted into Hall Quarry Beach.

# Swimming Lessons

## Learn to Swim Session Dates:

### Monday-Thursdays

**Session I:** June 19 - June 29

**Session II:** July 10 - July 20

**Saturdays:** June 17- August 5

Rain date make-ups are the weeks immediately following each session.

## Swim Test Date

Children will be required to come to the Quarry the Friday before lessons start for a pre-test at the same time that they are registered for. This will assure children are registered in the correct levels.

## Diaper Policy

Infants and Toddlers, 30 months of age or younger, must wear a swim diaper, tight fitting plastic or rubber pants or a swimsuit with a plastic or rubber lining during swim lessons. Swim diapers are available at the Quarry.

## Preschool with Parent

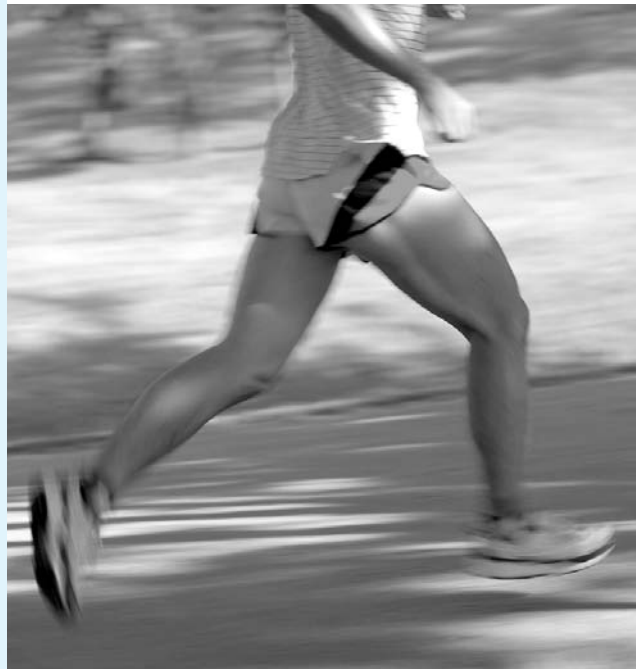

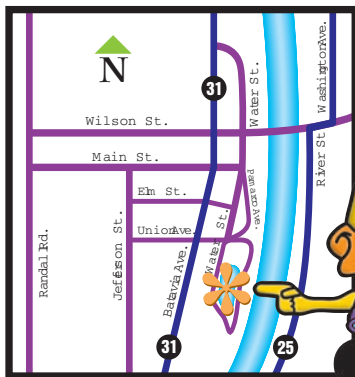
